Dr. Richard Harding Showcases Thermal Ablation Techniques at 94th Annual ATA Meeting in Scottsdale

At the American Thyroid Association's 94th Annual Meeting, Richard J. Harding, MD, FACS, presented "How to Start a Thermal Ablation Program," offering practical guidance on launching innovative treatments for thyroid nodules
